## 4. General

### The Asset Manager

Retirement Investments and Savings for Everyone Proprietary Limited (FSP number 49323) has been appointed by the Manager to manage the underlying assets of the Portfolio.

The Asset Manager is 100% owned by First World Trader (Pty) Ltd, trading as EasyEquities. The Asset Manager was established in 2018 and as of 31 October 2025 the total assets under management were R16.3 billion.

The Asset Manager provides investment solutions that support retirement investments and long-term savings outcomes for a broad range of investors, recognising the importance of disciplined retirement planning and savings to secure financial independence in later life – a key consideration given that many investors may struggle to accumulate sufficient retirement capital without structured investment solutions.

### Initial Listing

There is a total of 1,000 Securities that will be listed on the listing date.

Subscriptions for the Securities after the initial introduction are subject to the terms and conditions and procedures described in the Programme Memorandum.

### Net Asset Value (NAV)

The Net Asset Value (NAV) will be determined as described in the Programme Memorandum. The Manager will publish the daily NAV on its website at <https://etfs.easyequities.co.za/easyetf-instrument-page/easy5?hsLang=en-za>.

In addition to being available on the Manager's website, the NAV will also be shown in the daily Portfolio Composition File (PCF) and published in the quarterly factsheet, in accordance with the Act and the DSS Requirements. ### The Market Maker

The Manager has appointed Jane Street Financial Limited ("Jane Street") as the Market Maker. The Manager confirms that the Market Maker is independent from the AMETF and the Manager. The Market Maker will endeavour to provide and maintain a reasonable bid price (the price at which investors can sell) and offer price (the price at which investors can buy) through the central trading book of the JSE, subject to conditions set out in the Market Making Agreement.

The Manager confirms that the necessary procedures are in place to ensure that the Market Maker will only provide liquidity in the market based on information available in the public domain to comply with the provisions of the Financial Markets Act 19 of 2012.

The JSE may, at its discretion, relieve the Issuer and the Market Maker from their responsibility to maintain a reasonable bid and offer in certain circumstances, including (but not limited to):

- when there is no bid and offer in the underlying market, or
- when the issuer is experiencing technical difficulties.

Such relief may apply for a specific period or for a particular issuance of securities.

The EasyETFs CPI + 5 AMETF will invest in sufficiently liquid securities, and the Market Maker is duly appointed in terms of the DSS Requirements to maintain liquidity in the secondary market.

The Manager will publish an announcement on SENS, if the liquidity provisions have been changed.

## Secondary Market Trading

Securities may be traded in the secondary market on the JSE and need not be traded in any minimum number.

Although a Market Maker has been appointed, there can be no assurance that active trading markets for the securities will develop, nor is there a certain basis for predicting the price levels at which the securities will trade.

The PCF will be published on the Manager's Website daily at <https://etfs.easyequities.co.za/easyetf-instrument-page/easy5?hsLang=en-za> and will be used by the Market Maker to determine the prices that it will buy and sell securities in the secondary market.

## Distributions

The intention of the Portfolio is for all income received by the Portfolio (other than capital gains on disposals), which will predominantly comprise dividends derived from underlying holdings of the portfolio, to be distributed to holders immediately following the end of the Accounting Period on an annual basis. All the payments will be made through a JSE approved central security depository on the announced payment date.

## Material Contracts Specific to This Supplement

The Manager has appointed the following entities to fulfil the functions specified in the Programme Memorandum and this Supplement thereto:

- Jane Street Financial Limited has been appointed as the liquidity provider (market maker) of the Portfolio.
- Retirement Investments and Savings for Everyone Proprietary Limited have been appointed as the Asset Manager for the Portfolio.

## Borrowings, Material Commitments and Contingent Liabilities

As at the last practicable date prior to the issue of this Supplement being 07 May 2026, no borrowings (as contemplated in the EasyETFs Programme Memorandum), material commitments, lease payments or contingent liabilities have been incurred and no debentures have been issued, nor have any loans been made by or in respect of the Portfolio or for the benefit of the Manager or any of its directors or their associates.

The directors of the Manager confirm that after due careful enquiry and with no involvement with the Auditors there have been no material changes in the financial position of the Manager since the end of the last financial period for which annual financial statements have been published.

## Litigation

There are no legal or arbitration proceedings of which the Manager is aware, including any such proceedings that are pending or threatened, that may have, or have had, a material effect on the financial position of the Manager or the Portfolio.

## Experts Consent

The Listings Advisor, Designated Person, Asset Manager and Liquidity Provider (Market Maker) have consented to their names being referred to in this Supplement in the form and context in which they are included and had not withdrawn their consent prior to issue of this Supplement.

## 5. Investment Policy

### Investment strategy

The Portfolio will be an actively managed exchange traded fund (“AMETF”) listed on the JSE. The Portfolio’s primary objective is to deliver a real return of CPI + 5% over any rolling five-year period, while maintaining a moderate-risk profile. The Portfolio emphasises a balance between capital appreciation and income generation. The Portfolio is expected to display moderate short-term volatility, while aiming for sustainable medium-term to long-term capital growth.

The Portfolio will be managed in accordance with the prudential investment requirements applicable to South African retirement funds (Regulation 28 of the Pension Funds Act), to the extent permitted by the Cisca; and the investment limitations applicable to the ASISA South African – Multi Asset – Medium Equity portfolio classification category.

The Portfolio will follow a research-driven investment strategy, informed by the Manager’s macro-economic outlook and market assessments. Investments will include individual securities and participatory interests in portfolios of collective investment schemes that align with the portfolio’s objectives, selected through robust due diligence. Asset selection criteria will include consistency of performance, soundness of investment process, management team experience, and appropriateness to the Portfolio’s moderate-risk profile. The strategy will emphasise capital growth, income-generation and volatility management, favouring instruments aligned with a medium equity risk tolerance.

### Investment theme and universe

To achieve its objective, the Portfolio will be invested in a diversified mix of permitted South African and foreign assets, appropriate to a medium equity multi-asset class portfolio. These assets may include South African and foreign: equities, listed property, bonds and other interest-bearing securities, cash, cash equivalents and money market instruments (collectively known as assets in liquid form), participatory interests in portfolios of collective investment schemes (including ETFs), and financial instruments (both listed and unlisted), subject to the conditions set out in the applicable legislation.

The Portfolio is permitted to invest in foreign assets, financial instruments (both listed and unlisted), subject to the conditions set out in applicable legislation.

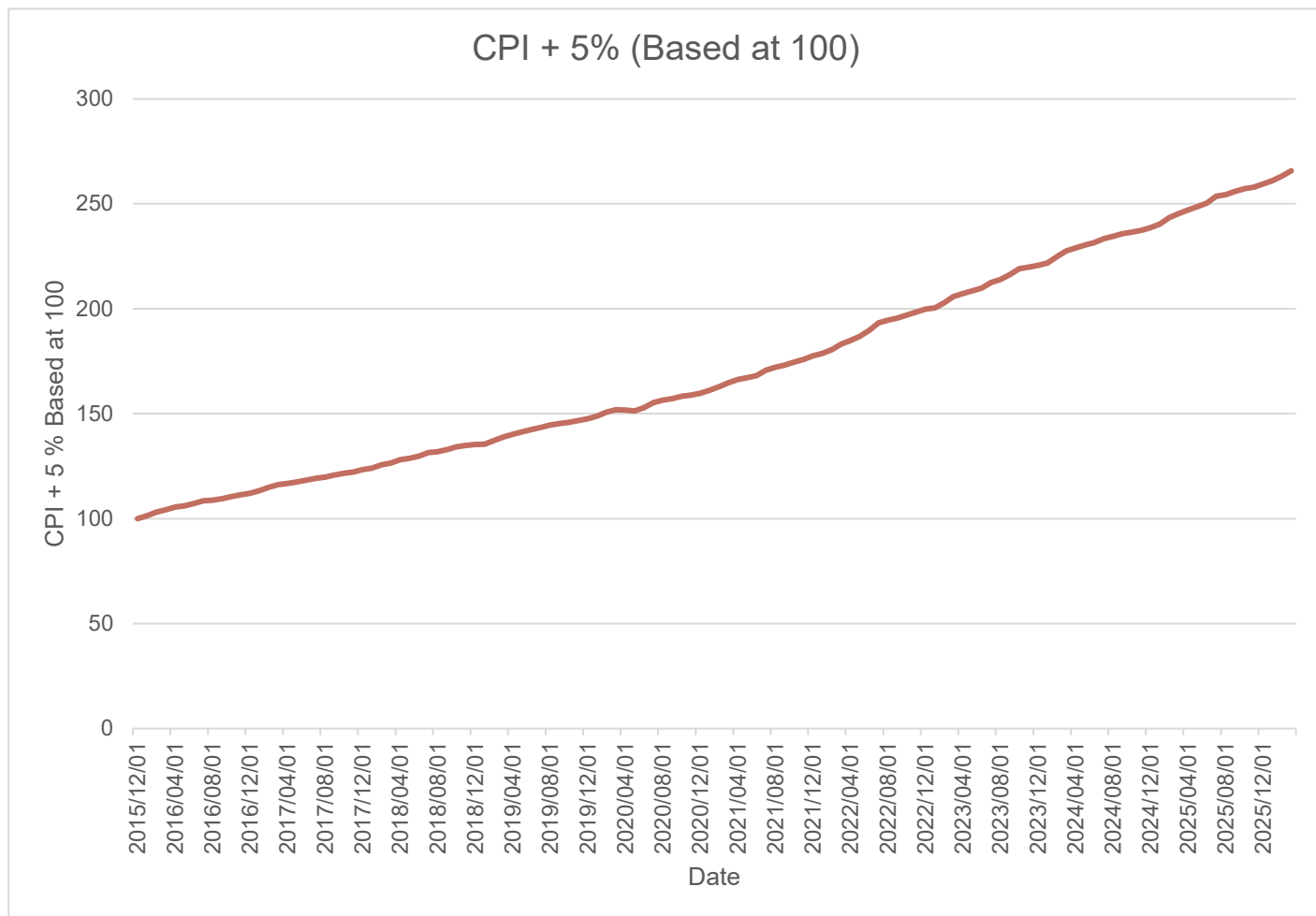
The Portfolio may also include participatory interests of any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes or other similar schemes, in addition, the Portfolio may invest in exchange traded funds or exchange traded notes whether organised as a portfolio of a collective scheme or not, subject to the conditions of the Act. Where the schemes are operated in territories other than South Africa, participatory interests or any other form of participation in these schemes will be included in the portfolio only where the regulatory environment is to the satisfaction of the Manager and Trustee and is of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa.

Investors may obtain participatory interests in the portfolio on the secondary market or by subscribing for new participatory interest in the portfolio on the primary market. In order to achieve this objective, the Manager may, subject to the Act and the Deed, create and issue or redeem and cancel an unlimited number of participatory interests in the Portfolio.

### Applicable portfolio benchmark

The Portfolio's benchmark is a real return of CPI + 5% over any rolling five-year period.

## 7. Management and Other Fees

The Manager has determined that the management fee charged will be a basic fee designed primarily to recover costs related to the direct operational management of the Portfolio, subject to a maximum fee of 0.65% (65 basis points) (VAT exclusive) per annum.

The Manager is entitled to a management fee per calendar month calculated as follows:

$$\frac{D \times 0.65\%}{365} \times N$$

Where:

D = the daily market value of the total assets of the portfolio excluding income accruals and permissible

deductions, if any and

N = number of days in the month in question; or

Any lower amount nominated at the Manager's discretion.

The management fee is accrued daily and is accordingly based on the daily market value of the total assets of the Portfolio over each Accounting Period.

The Manager may change any charge for the Portfolio, introduce additional charges or change the method of calculation of any charge that could result in an increase in charges, provided that:

- not less than 3 months' written notice has been given to every Investor by notification through SENS and on the Manager's website; and
- the necessary amendments to the supplements of the EasyETFs Scheme have been affected in consultation with the FSCA and the JSE.

In addition, the Manager may charge a creation fee or a redemption fee in connection with the expenditure incurred and administration performed by it in respect of the creation, issue and sale or repurchase of the Securities. The Manager may at any time in its discretion waive or rebate any fee and/or redemption fee (or any portion thereof), in respect of all Investors, any category of Investor or any Investor.

### Total Expense Ratio

The total expense ratio ("TER") of the portfolio reflects the percentage of the average NAV that was incurred as charges, levies and fees related to the management of the Portfolio. It is an annualised figure which will be calculated every quarter and published as required.

### Transaction Cost

The transaction cost ("TC") of the Portfolio reflects the percentage of the value of the Portfolio that was incurred as cost relating to the buying and selling of the underlying assets of the Portfolio. It is an annualised figure which will be calculated every quarter and published as required.

## 8. Changes to the Supplement

If the Manager makes any changes to this Supplement that affect the terms and conditions of the Portfolio, other than changes which are of a formal, minor or technical nature or are made to correct manifest errors or to comply with mandatory provisions of the law, the Manager will obtain approval from Investors in terms the ballot process as described in the Deed and regulated by the FSCA.

The Manager will announce on SENS when there are any changes to the liquidity provision as described above in the section dealing with secondary market trading as well as any other changes to the Supplement.

The procedures for Investors to exercise their votes to ensure that they are enabled to exercise their vote will be published by the Manager on SENS and circulars providing details of changes will be made available on the Manager's website at <https://etfs.easyequities.co.za/easyetf-instrument-page/easy5?hsLang=en-za>.


